All of our students are required to participate in community service projects. Providing service to others is an important part of citizenship. It also provides a way for our students to expand their learning to areas that might prove to be of interest to them in the future. It is an opportunity for our students to become involved in community activities beyond the schoolroom.

Students are required to attain 40 hours of community service by the time they complete their senior year. In the case of our current 12th graders, their requirement is pro-rated to 30 hours.
