Please do not label anything.

Please bring in the following to your homeroom -

2 dozen pencils (#2)

2 dozen pens (erasable blue or black ink)

2 highlighters

1 package of loose-leaf paper - 200 plus sheets - wide ruled

1 portable pencil sharpener with cover or lid

1 package expo dry erase low-odor markers

1 container cleaning wipes.

1 package magic markers or colored pencils or crayons

2 glue sticks

1 Flash Drive

Math and Science

3 hard covered composition books

(100 sheets, preferably 3 different colors and/or designs)

3 PLASTIC 2-pocket folders

(Plastic, preferably different colors and/or designs)

ELA and Social Studies

*2" (or larger) three ring, sturdy binder for ela and ss and two plastic **folder** dividers*

1 plastic homework folder to be stapled into the student's AP (assignment pad which will be given out in school)

3-hole pencil case.

2 packages of post-its → size 3"x3"

Special Class - 1 folder - to be used multiple times throughout the year.

Homework supplies (to be kept at home)

Loose-leaf, highlighter, crayons or colored pencils, paper, pencils,

*pen, glue,
1 calculator, and metric ruler*

No backpacks on wheels, they do not fit in the lockers.

****Special Note:*** *Please keep a box (large shoe box or file cabinet folders in a file cabinet) at home so that students can save all important papers (old tests, quizzes, information papers, typed notes from teacher,...) from each subject for the year. We recommend putting papers from the folders into the box about every two weeks. These will be used to study from when FINALS come around in June.*
