Sixth Grade General Supplies List

1 **extra-large** zipper binder that will hold all your supplies!

Extra zippered sections recommended!!!

1 pair of ear buds/ear phones for lap-top use

1 flash drive for lap-top use

4 packages of loose leaf paper - 200 plus sheets - wide ruled-(**2 will be collected**)

Two dozen #2 pencils-sharpened

Two dozen pens - Erasermate, if possible - black or blue

8 to 12 colored pencils

3-hole pencil case

2 highlighters

3 boxes of tissues

1 pack index cards

post-its

Math/Reading

1 **1 inch** sturdy vinyl binder NOTE: It must lay flat when opened!

1 package (1-inch) paper fasteners (box of 100)

1 package of dividers with metal/reinforced holes- **DO NOT LABEL THEM YET!**

1 plastic double pocket 3-hole punch folder **labeled Math**

1 plastic double pocket 3- hole punch folder **labeled Reading**

1 hard covered black composition book (100 pages) **labeled Reading**

ELA

3 hard covered black composition books (100 pages) **labeled ELA**

1 plastic double pocket, 3- hole punch folder **labeled ELA**

Science

1 composition notebook (**colored**) **labeled science**

1 plastic double pocket, 3 hole punch **labeled Science**

Social Studies

2 **one-subject** spiral notebooks **labeled social studies**

1 plastic double pocket, 3 hole punch folder, **labeled Social Studies**

The zippered binder should be able to hold 5 folders, a 1-subject spiral notebook(SS), two compositions books(ELA and Science), the 1 inch binder(Math/Reading), and your pencil case with other supplies. Leave index cards, post-its, flash-drive, and headphones in the locker on the first day. Put folders in the zippered binder, not the 1-inch binder. Fill the 1-inch binder with 1/2 package of looseleaf and the dividers will be labeled in school the first day! Two packages of looseleaf paper and tissue boxes will be collected the first day. The opened package of looseleaf can be kept in locker for refills, and leave one package at home for homework.

Specials

1 folder to be used throughout the year

2 dry erase markers
