participated in the first Summer Reading Challenge which was introduced to help maintain the level of reading achieved during the school year. If a student read for 30


minutes each day and completed the reading log, he/she received a small prize each Thursday during the summer. Students who participated all summer will be acknowledged at a school-wide assembly.
