




Grade 5 - Grade Level Cohort







Grade 5 - Grade Level Cohort




Grade 7 - Grade Level Cohort






Grade 8 - Grade Level Cohort



Indicates the Percentage of Students Scoring a 3 or 4








#### Putnam Valley C.S.D. N.Y.S. English/Language Arts Regents Results




#### Putnam Valley C.S.D. N.Y.S. Algebra Regents Results



## Putnam Valley C.S.D. N.Y.S. Geometry Regents Results % of Students at Proficiency and Mastery




#### Putnam Valley C.S.D. N.Y.S. Algebra 2/ Trigonometry Regents Results





Putnam Valley C.S.D. N.Y.S. U.S. History Regents Results % of Students at Proficiency and Mastery





% of Students at Proficiency and Mastery








# SAT Mean Results: Reading, Math & Writing
